2019 Spring Semester Scholarships Given

Huree University appreciates Angel Donors who provided scholarships for students last year. The 2019 Spring Semester Scholarship Certificate ceremony was held on February 14, 2019, at 11:30 am in the auditorium. A total of 211 students received scholarships: 44 students received full scholarship awards, 77 students earned 50% of the tuition, and 90 students received scholarships with 25% of the tuition. Huree is planning to have a ceremony in the near future for students who will receive direct scholarship awards from Angel Donors.

Huree also introduced new faculty members who will teach at Huree University beginning the Spring semester. Erkhembayar Solongo received the National Scholarship from the Korean Government (GKS : Global Korea Scholarship), and faculty and students had a farewell because he will attend the Chungbuk National University in South Korea. We also recognized nine exchange students who will study at Universities in South Korea for a year.



The 8th Huree University Seminar

The annual Huree University Seminar was held successfully on November 23, 2018. It was well attended by many students and foreign and international guests.

A total of fourteen papers were presented during the seminar. Nine outstanding papers were selected; three papers were selected for high academic recognition received awards.

The papers include: 'Problems and solutions in common use of terrestrial and satellite communication in Mongolia' by Professor Otgon Bartar of IC (Information Communication)

Department, 'A Study on Human Health Using traditional Mongolian liquor' by Ko Jae-Hyung of BT (Bio-Technology) Department, and 'Study on side effects, countermeasures and treatment of PC game addiction' by Professor Ireduui of IB (Internet Business) department.

Huree University is looking forward to having another seminar in 2019 with innovative high-quality papers from diverse disciplines.



Multimedia (MM) Department Exhibition

The Multimedia (MM) seminar and the student project exhibition was held on December 6-8, 2018 in the Professor Kwak Min-Soo Memorial Hall in building B. The Hall was named in memory of Dr. Kwak in 2018 who dedicated his life teaching Huree students in Mongolia. Dr. Kawk was a Korean-American.

One hundred and fifty student projects were displayed, and each student submitted two of their

creative projects: freshman-drawing and computer practice, sophomore-application design and 3D modeling, and junior-web design and video.



A Celebration of 'Korean Cultural Day'

Huree University King Sejong Institute in collaboration with Huree Elementary School, Secondary School, and Kindergarten co-sponsored the first "Korean Cultural Day." More than 1,000 people gathered in the Mongolian Labor Union Auditorium including local Mongolian and Korean residents and Mongolian students to celebrate Korean culture on December 14, 2018.

The purpose of the event was to

promote Korean culture in Mongolia. Approximately 1,000 Mongolian students participated in the celebration with Korean food tasting, trying on Hanbok (traditional Korean dress), Samulnori (Korean common people's dance with traditional musical instruments), and K-Pop performances. The Mongol K-Pop contest was the highlight of the event. A taekwondo demonstration reminded the participants of Koreans' spirit at a closing ceremony, and raffle prizes were given to the participants.



Huree University Elementary and Secondary School Achievement Presentation

The first-grade students presented their academic achievement on March 19, 2019, in the Huree University auditorium.

Approximately 150 parents attended and celebrated their children's accomplishments. These children started the first grade last September, and they learned mathematics and Mongolian, Korean, and English languages.

They presented their achievements through poem, song, and dance.
